## PREVIEW – OPEN WATER SWIMMING

**After 36 years: Open Water Europeans return to its roots – In 2025, tradition will meet the future: Stari Grad celebrates the première of the 3km knockout sprints – 20 federations to participate**

Stari Grad (EA) – With a bunch of top swimmers dominating the open water scene in recent years, the 21st edition of the European Aquatics Open Water Swimming Championships, to take place in the historic and picturesque town of Stari Grad on the island of Hvar, Croatia, promises no less than top level competitions. To date 91 athletes (43 female and 48 male) have confirmed their entries.

Stari Grad is a very special venue as it was there that the first-ever edition of this competition was held in 1989. To return to this spot is to return to the roots of European open water swimming. Initially held as stand-alone events, the Championships were integrated in the European Aquatics Championships in Vienna in 1995, when the competitions were carried out in an arm of the “Old Danube”.

This May, the crystal-clear waters of the Adriatic Sea will offer a perfect setting for the European Open Water highlight. In addition to the **5km** and **10km** races as well as the **mixed relay**, the so-called **3km knockout** event will be introduced – instead of the 25km races that were carried out for the last time in 2024.

### **Hungary and Italy top favourites – Germany and France among the medal contenders**

Altogether 20 European Aquatics member federations entered the seven events and a glimpse at the all-time medal table shows that **Italy** will once again be one of the top favourites in Stari Grad – in the women's as well as the men's competitions.

With altogether 20 medals in 2024 and 2022 (7 of them gold) as well as 95 medals since the inauguration of the Championships in 1989, there is no doubt of Italy's outstanding role as top favourite – especially as they can count on their open water aces like Giorgio Paltrinieri, Dario Verani, Ginevra Taddeucci, Barbara Pozzobon or Giulia Gabrieleschi.

With their top stars, Paris Olympic champion Kristof Rasovszky and bronze medallist David Betlehem, **Hungary**'s open water aces might be the strongest opponents of the Italians. With 2 gold and 2 bronze medals at the last edition, they have underlined their great ambitions and will be trying to further improve their medal tallies (altogether 21).

**France** has entered their top stars Logan Fontaine, Damien Joly and Marc-Antoine Olivier to further increase their medal tally (38). **Germany** (67) places its hopes on Lea Boy and Jeanette Spiwoks as well as on their newcomers as Florian Wellbrock, Olympic runner-up Oliver Klemet and Leonie Beck will not be part of the team line-up this time. The **Netherlands**, in the past years always among the title contenders and boasting a total medal tally of 29, will not compete in Stari Grad at all.

### **Men's events: Rasovszky, Betlehem, Paltrinieri, Olivier, Pardoe guarantee “Olympic level”**

On the opening day on Wednesday (May 28) numerous illustrious names will guarantee an amazing event in the 10km race: Olympic and World champion Kristof Rasovszky, Olympic bronze medallist David Betlehem, multiple World and European champion Gregorio “King Greg” Paltrinieri, as well as Great Britain's 2024 World bronze medallist Hector Pardoe or Marc-Antoine Olivier and Logan

Fontain from France. They all will all be fighting for a top podium finish. On Friday, they will also hunt for the first ever title in the new 3km knockout race.

### **Women's events: New champions to be crowned**

The women's events boast a wide range of world-class athletes, too. Leonie Beck however, the 2023 double World as well as 2023 and 2024 double European champion in the 5km and 10km event, will not be competing. After the Paris Olympics, when she “only” finished on 9th place in difficult conditions, she decided to take a kind of “sabbatical”. In Cyprus at the open water Euro Cup Beck, who celebrated her 28<sup>th</sup> birthday on May 27, also worked as a kind of “race reporter” for European Aquatics Television.

In the absence of Beck and the Dutch Olympic champion Sharon van Rouwendaal, new European champions will be crowned in the women's events. There is quite a group of strong competitors – such as for example Italy's Olympic bronze medallist Ginevra Taddeucci, Giulia Gabrieleschi (3<sup>rd</sup> 5km at the 2022 Europeans) and Barbara Pozzobon, Hungary's European champion Bettina Fabian, as well as Spaniard Maria de Valdez or Beck's compatriots Lea Boy.

Boy, the 2021 European 25km champion and 2024 runner-up in this event, wrote swimming history in Ibiza last month, winning the World Cup debuts of the three-stage knockout sprint, when she crossed the finish line 3.6 seconds ahead of Hungary's Fabian. Fabian's teammate David Betlehem took 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the men's race behind Germany's Klemet then.

### **WHAT'S NEW?! - 3km knockout sprint to celebrate European debut**

Knockout sprints are elimination races over a total of three kilometres. Athletes swim consecutive laps of 1500m, 1000m, and 500m. The slower competitors are eliminated in the first two heats. This format will be part of the World Championships program at the Worlds in Singapore (July 11 to August 3). Before being included on the World Cup calendar, knockout sprints have already been tested at Junior World Championships one year ago.

### **Team event: Germany and Italy hot on the heels of defending champion Hungary**

Italy snatched European gold in the team event six times – the last two times in Budapest 2021 and on home soil in Rome 2022. Germany earned the World title in 2022. Hungary, who secured the crown in the team event for the very first time last year in Belgrade, will be trying to keep the competitors from Italy and Germany at bay to defend the title.

The team event – introduced to the European programme in 2008 – always offers a great opportunity to show team spirit and there is not a shadow of a doubt that this event will be an exciting and emotional conclusion of the Open Water competitions on May 31.
