PREVIEW – DIVING

23 Federations eyeing 39 medals in Antalya – Germany, Great Britain, Italy and Ukraine with the strongest teams – New diving champions in 3 disciplines in sight

Antalya (EA) – Divers from 23 Federations - 3 less than in Belgrade 2024 (26) and exactly the same number as in Rome 2022 - will set their eyes on the medals at the upcoming European Aquatics Diving Championships in Antalya. The city of millions on the Turkish riviera will welcome numerous diving powerhouses like Germany, Great Britain, Italy and the Ukraine. From the “big ones”, only France, which landed five medals in Belgrade (2 gold by Gwendal Bisch/3m and Jules Bouyer/Alexis Jandard/3m Synchro), 1 silver and 2 bronze), will be missing.

The 23 Federations will send a total of 97 athletes – 43 females and 54 males. Among them are some highly decorated divers as well as numerous young promising talents. The competitions seven weeks ahead of the 2025 World Championships in Singapore will be a great opportunity to gain confidence and competition practice.

A total of 39 medals in 13 diving events will be awarded in the Gloria Sports Arena: 1m, 3m springboard, 10m platform, 3m and 10m synchro, each for men and women, as well as the team event and the mixed synchronised events on the 3m springboard and the 10m platform.

Diving (3m springboard and 10m platform) has been on the programme of the European Aquatic Championships since its first edition in 1926 in Budapest (in the men’s category; the women entered one year later in Bologna). The synchronised events were introduced to the European Championships for the first time in 1997.

The team event – an official European Championship event since 2012 – will be held for the 13th time, while “new” rules (4 divers instead of 2) will apply for the sixth time. The mixed synchronised events celebrated their premiere at the 2016 Europeans in London.

Keeping in mind that after the 2021 Europeans in Budapest and the 2022 edition in Rome the diving elite also met in Rzeszow, Poland, where the complete diving programme with 13 events had been a part of the 2023 European Games, and the last edition in Belgrade 2024, the event in Antalya will be the fifth European Championships in as many years.

The competitions are going to be held outdoors – since 2010 (Budapest), 2022 (Rome) and 2024 (Belgrade) for the fourth time under (hopefully) blue skies. Since the 2013 FINA World Championships in Barcelona (5 out of the first seven World Champs were held outdoors in the new millennium: 2003, 2005, 2009, 2011, 2013), most major diving competitions moved indoors: Olympics, Worlds, Europeans. Only the 2016 Olympics in Rio were carried out outdoors.

10 of the 13 European champions from Belgrade entered the respective events and will be trying to defend their titles. Antalya will see new European champions in 3 events.

Germany entered all 13 events, Italy and Ukraine to start in 12, Great Britain in 11, Spain in 10 competitions

From the four European “diving powerhouses”, Germany has entered all 13 events. The Ukrainians (Mixed 3m synchro) as well as Italy (Women’s 10m synchro) only skipped one event, while Great Britain will not compete in the women’s 1m springboard and the women’s 10m synchro event. Spain entered 10 competitions, they skipped the women’s 1m, 3m and 3m synchro.

During the past years, **Germany** had to compensate the retirements of their multiple medallists Tina Punzel, Martin Wolfram and Patrick Hausding, who is still the most successful diver in the history of the European Championships with 15 European titles to his name. Without their top divers, who concentrated on the 2024 Olympics in Paris, the Germans missed the top-spot in Belgrade and left the Serbian capital with “only” one silver and two bronze. In Antalya, Moritz Wesemann will head the 9-athletes strong team with the already experienced Lena Hentschel and Jette Mueller as well as promising talents such as Pauline Pfeif or Ole Roesler. Timo Barthel, the 2023 European 10m champion, 29 years of age, is the oldest diver of Team Germany, changed to the 3m springboard event after several injuries and altogether five surgeries since the Paris Olympics.

Italy’s hopes lie on a really competitive team with “big names” such as Elena Bertocchi (5 gold – 3 silver – 2 bronze / 10), Chiara Pellacani (7-5-4/16), Giovanni Tocci (0-4-3/7), Lorenzo Marsaglia (1-6-3/10) or Matteo Santoro (2-2-1/5). These five of the altogether 9 Italian divers won almost 50 European medals for Italy in the past decade.

Ukraine counts on Sofiia Lyskun, Kseniya Bailo, Danylo Konovalov, Stanislav Oliferchuk and especially on their super star, “wonderkid” Oleksii Sereda, who missed the last edition in Belgrade. The now 19-year-old took his first of altogether 3 European platform titles in Kyiv in 2019 in front of a home crowd. On that day – August 11, 2019 – Sereda (13 years and 7 months) inherited the title of the youngest European Champion from Great Britain’s Tom Daley, who was 13 years and 10 months old, when he sensationally won European platform gold in Eindhoven in March 2008. Since then, Sereda has not only grown some centimetres but also gained a lot of competition experience. He has entered the 10m as well as the 10m synchro (together with Mark Hrytsenko).

Great Britain, who topped the medal table in Belgrade (4 gold, 3 bronze – altogether 7) and Rome (6-3-3 / 12) is ready to parade with Desharne Bent-Ashmeil and Amy Rollinson, who claimed gold in the 3m synchro event at the 2023 and 2024 Europeans. Both will try to win their third title in a row in Antalya. Bent-Ashmeil also arrives as defending champion in the 3m individual event and the Mixed 3m synchro (with Ben Cutmore). 2024 European 10m champion Robbie Lee only entered the 10m synchro event this time. However Cutmore, the 2024 bronze medallist, is going for medals in the individual platform event as well as in the Mixed 3m synchro.

Spain, Sweden and Austria arrive with Belgrade Champions – Switzerland back with Michelle Heimberg

Spain created a really positive surprise, ending on second place in Belgrade 2024 and making a big step in the all-time medal table with 3 gold and 3 silver. Their so far only gold medal in diving dates back to 1999, when José Miguel Gil won gold in the 1m-event ahead of Germans Andreas Wels and Stefan Ahrens at the Europeans in Istanbul. With a 7-member-strong team including the 10m European champion from Belgrade, Ana Carvajal, they want to repeat the good results of Belgrade.

Sweden and **Austria** might also play an important role when the medals will be awarded. Especially Austria created one of the big surprises in Belgrade when Anton Knoll and Dariush Lotfi took the European crown in the 10m-synchro-event. Both will try to win their second subsequent title.

Elna Widerstrom and Emilia Nilsson Garip (who is not part of the 2025 team) however continued a long tradition for Sweden, winning gold and bronze in the 1m-event in Belgrade as well as following in the footsteps of Sweden's diving icons, the 1972 Olympic champion Ulrika Knape and her daughter Anna Lindberg (3-time European Champion 1m 2008/2012 and 3m 2011).

Norway (1 silver by Helle Tuxen/3m) and **Ireland** (1 bronze by Clare Cryan/3m) both made their first appearance in the all-time medal table in Belgrade. **Poland** won a complete set, with "oldie" Andrzej Rzeszutek, winning gold in the 1m-event and bronze in the 3m synchro with his long-time teammate Kacper Lesiak. Aleksandra Blazowksa added one silver in the 1m-event. All three will also compete - Rzeszutek, born in 1991 and aged 33, will be the oldest competitor in Antalya.

Switzerland missed the Europeans 2024 but will be back this year – among others with their top diver Michelle Heimberg. After winning the first-ever Swiss diving medal in history in 2017, a silver in the women's 3m event, Heimberg claimed another silver in 2022 and bronze in 2023. In 2023, the 24-year-old caused another surprise, winning the gold medal in the women's 1m event.

Host **Turkey** entered 3 divers. 19-year-old Sude Koprulu (1m/3m) as well as the 18-year-old Simay Arslankan and Ece Erzincan in the women's Synchro 3m will represent the host country. Koprulu attended the last edition in Belgrade, finishing 13th and 15th in the women's 3m- and 1m-event.

Prize money for all medallists

In 2009, the first-ever stand-alone European Diving Championships (former European Diving Cup) took place in Turin, Italy. Since then, the divers have had the opportunity to compete in a continental event each year. In even years, diving is part of the European Aquatic Championships (due to the postponement of the 2020 edition the stand-alone diving Europeans weren't held that year). Since Rostock 2015, LEN offers prize money for all medal winners at the diving championships and, additionally, travel assistance for all participating nations.

Here is the breakdown of the prize money for the respective events:

- **Individual events** -> 1st Place: 2,000 € - 2nd Place: 1,500 € - 3rd Place: 1,000 €
- **Synchro/Team events** -> 1st Place: 2,500 € - 2nd Place: 2,000 € - 3rd Place: 1,500 €
